New York City Passenger Manifests of SS Titanic Survivors Rescued by the SS Carpathia

A ssuming that a search for the manifests for the survivors of the SS Titanic would be easy, I was surprised when nothing appeared for either that ship, nor the SS Carpathia. If other researchers had looked for the manifests, apparently most researchers never found them. In the end, answers were to be found.

"The Carpathia was eastward bound when she rescued the Titanic passengers, and returned to NY to land them. Apr. 19, 1912. Volume 4183." This was handwritten on the "Index of passenger and crew lists from June 18 to June 19, 1912 for New York City."

The SS Carpathia was owned and operated by the Cunard Line. The ship had sailed between England and New York City, but most often sailed from Italy, and other ports in the Mediterranean Sea, to New York City. It appears that the manifests were not returned to port authorities until June 18, 1912 during a subsequent voyage exactly two months later.

Obviously incomplete, approximately only 500 people were mentioned in the manifests. A total of nineteen Finns are recorded in these manifests, including one Finnish citizen who last resided in Sweden with her two young children and were traveling to their husband and father in Illinois. These last three survivors have not been previously included in the Migration Institute's list of Ti-

tanic V. Four previously-identified Finnish survivors are not included in these manifests which were returned on June 18th. A transcript of those people is listed below.

A couple entries contained numerical notations which were added years later. They are very small and difficult to read. Most likely they refer to either dates and places of naturalization, or perhaps US passports issued.

In 1999 the annual meeting of the AEMI, with a seminar, will take place at *The Slovene Emigration Studies*, Ljubljana, Slovenia.


